

ORDER

Complainant filed nine judicial complaints during the first ten months of 2015, all of which were dismissed pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A).

Under Rule 10(a), Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings, "[a] complainant who has filed repetitive, harassing, or frivolous complaints, or has otherwise abused the complaint procedure, may be restricted from filing further complaints." Complainant's prior judicial complaints have been frivolous and repetitive. In light of his pattern of frivolous filings, complainant is ordered to show cause within 30 days of the filing of this order why he should not be restricted from filing further judicial complaints.
