




courts or failed to discharge his duties by reason of mental or physical disability.\*

This complaint is, accordingly, dismissed pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(i), as failing to allege misconduct or disability under 28 U.S.C. § 351(a).
