PER CURIAM:

Appellants appeal the district court's order granting summary judgment to Peninsula Regional Medical Center on their employment discrimination/retaliation claims. We have reviewed the record and the parties' briefs, as well as the district court's opinion, and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm on the reasoning of the district court. Conaway v. Peninsula Regional Medical Ctr., No. CA-99-193-S (D. Md. Dec. 22, 1999).
