PER CURIAM:

Kimberly Jajack appeals the district court's order granting United Airlines, Inc.'s motion for summary judgment in this employment discrimination action. We have reviewed the record, and the transcripts of the relevant hearings in light of Jajack's arguments on appeal, and we find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm the order of the district court. Jajack v. United Airlines, Inc., No. CA-99-1566-A (E.D. Va. filed May 30, 2000; entered May 31, 2000).
