PER CURIAM:

Eddie Currence appeals the district court's order granting relief for Defendants in Currence's action claiming age discrimination in employment. We have reviewed the record and the district court's opinion and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm on the reasoning of the district court. See Currence v. Bruce Hardwood Flooring Ltd.
