PER CURIAM:

Priscilla Hines filed this mandamus petition challenging the district court's remand of her action alleging error in the amount of her social security retirement checks. Because this petition seeks the identical relief sought in an earlier petition filed by Hines, which was denied by this court, and because Hines presents no reason to question the propriety of that decision, we deny mandamus relief.
