PER CURIAM:

Neil Williams appeals the district court's order dismissing his 42 U.S.C.A. § 1983 (West Supp. 1999) complaint pursuant to 28 U.S.C.A. § 1915A (West Supp. 1999). We have reviewed the record and the district court's opinion accepting the magistrate judge's recommendation and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm substantially on the reasoning of the district court. See Williams v. Prime Care Medical, No. CA-99-147 (N.D.W. Va., Jan. 25, 2000).
