PER CURIAM:

Rickie Latimer appeals the district court's order denying relief on his 42 U.S.C.A. § 1983 (West Supp. 2000) complaint. We have reviewed the record and the district court's opinion and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm on the reasoning of the district court. See Latimer v. North Carolina Parole Comm'n, No. CA-98-854-5-BR (E.D.N.C. Mar. 3, 2000).
