PER CURIAM:

Garfield William Holley appeals magistrate judge's order denying his motions to set aside the jury's verdict in favor of Appellee and to alter or amend its final judgment.* We have reviewed the record and the district court's opinion and find no abuse of discretion. Accordingly, we affirm the order of the district court. See Holley v. Baker, No. CA-98-643-7 (W.D. Va. Apr. 26, 2000). We also deny Holley's motion for the appointment of counsel.
