PER CURIAM:

Colon Alston, Jr., a North Carolina inmate, appeals the district court's order denying relief on his 42 U.S.C.A. § 1983 (West Supp. 2000) complaint under 28 U.S.C.A. § 1915A (West Supp. 2000). We have reviewed the record and the district court's opinion and find that this appeal is frivolous. Accordingly, we dismiss the appeal on the reasoning of the district court. See Alston v. Tillery Corr. Inst., No. CA-00-162-5-BR (E.D.N.C. Apr. 20, 2000).
