PER CURIAM:

Thomas, Lord of Shalford, and Linda, Lady of Shalford, appeal the district court's order granting summary judgment in this diversity action. We have reviewed the record and the district court's opinion and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm on the reasoning of the district court. Lord of Shalford v.
