PER CURIAM:

Edward Anderson appeals the district court's order dismissing his various state law claims and granting summary judgment to the Defendants on his claim under his Title VII, 42 U.S.C.A. §§ 2000e to 2000e-17 (West 1994 & Supp. 2000). We have reviewed the record and the district court's opinion and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm on the reasoning of the district court. See Anderson v.
