PER CURIAM:

Edward Sutton, Jr. appeals the district court's order denying relief on his 42 U.S.C.A. § 1983 (West Supp. 2000) complaint and denying his motion for appointment of counsel. We have reviewed the record and the district court's opinion accepting the magistrate judge's recommendation and find no reversible error.
