PER CURIAM:

Willie J. Harrison appeals from the district court's order denying relief on his 42 U.S.C.A. § 1983 (West Supp. 2000) complaint. We have reviewed the record and the district court's opinion accepting the magistrate judge's recommendation and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm the district court's order granting summary judgment in favor of Defendants. See 42 U.S.C.A. § 1997e(e) (West Supp. 2000); Carter v.
