PER CURIAM:

Alvon Allen Thomas appeals the district court's order denying his motion filed under 28 U.S.C.A. § 2255 (West Supp. 2001). We have reviewed the record and the district court's opinion accepting the recommendation of the magistrate judge and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we deny Thomas' motions for a certificate of appealability and dismiss the appeal on the reasoning of the district court. United States v. Thomas, Nos.
