PER CURIAM:

Nicholas Warner Jones appeals the district court's order construing his petition for a writ of mandamus as a motion for reconsideration of a previous order dismissing as successive his 28 U.S.C.A. § 2254 (West 1994 & Supp. 2001) petition, and denying such motion. We have reviewed the record and the district court's opinion and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we deny a certificate of appealability and dismiss the appeal on the reasoning of the district court. See Jones v. Conroy, No. CA-01-1792-L (D. Md. filed Aug. 1, 2001; entered Aug. 3, 2001).
