PER CURIAM:

Keith Eric Saunders seeks to appeal the district court's order denying his motion filed under 28 U.S.C.A. § 2255 (West Supp. 2001). We have reviewed the record and the district court's opinion accepting the recommendation of the magistrate judge and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we deny a certificate of appealability and dismiss the appeal on the reasoning of the district court. See United States v. Saunders, Nos. CR-95-251, CA-00-681-1 (M.D.N.C. July 3, 2001).
