PER CURIAM:

Kenneth Dawson seeks review of the Benefits Review Board's decision and order affirming the administrative law judge's award of longshore disability benefits pursuant to 33 U.S.C. §§ 901-950 (2000). Our review of the record discloses that the Board's decision is based upon substantial evidence and is without reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm on the reasoning of the Board. See Dawson v. Ceres Marine Terminals, No. 03-801-BRB (BRB Aug. 25, 2004).
