PER CURIAM:

Anthony Jesus Sanders appeals the district court's orders denying relief on his 42 U.S.C. § 1983 (2000) complaint. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. See Sanders v. Bohnaker, No. CA-03-942-1 (E.D. Va. filed Aug. 6, 2003 & entered August 8, 2003; filed Sept. 28, 2004 & entered Sept. 30, 2004). Sanders' motion to dismiss James P. Bohnaker as a party to the appeal is denied as moot.
