PER CURIAM:

Roger Azangue Tsafah, a native and citizen of Cameroon, petitions for review of an order of the Board of Immigration Appeals (Board) denying a motion to reopen. We have reviewed the administrative record and the Board's order and find that the Board did not abuse its discretion in denying the motion to reopen. See INS v. Doherty, 502 U.S. 314, 323-24 (1992). Accordingly, we deny the petition for review for the reasons stated by the Board. See In re Tsafah, No. A76-919-174 (B.I.A. May 10, 2005).
