PER CURIAM:

Paul L. Register and Patricia Register appeal the district court's order and judgment granting summary judgment to Flagstar Bank, FSB, and Equiplus, Incorporated, and dismissing their complaint. We have reviewed the record and the district court's order and affirm for the reasons cited by the district court. See Register v. Flagstar Bank, No. CA-04-68-FL (E.D.N.C. Sept. 2, 2005).
