PER CURIAM:

Anthony Leon Hoover seeks to appeal the district court's order adopting the magistrate judge's recommendation and dismissing his complaint under 42 U.S.C. § 1983 (2000) as frivolous under 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(2)(B) (2000). We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm substantially on the reasoning of the district court. See Hoover v. Keith, No. CA-04-1047 (M.D.N.C. Jan. 4, 2005).
