PER CURIAM:

Joseph J. Schepis, Jr., a federal prisoner, appeals the district court's order accepting the recommendation of the magistrate judge and denying relief on his petition filed under 28 U.S.C. § 2241 (2000). We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm on the reasoning of the district court. See Schepis v. Hamidullah, No. CA-04-21977-0-17BD (D.S.C. filed Jan. 13 & entered Jan. 18, 2005). We deny Schepis' motion for a certificate of appealability as unnecessary.
