PER CURIAM:

Aminata Bubu Kamara, a native and citizen of Sierra Leone, petitions for review of an order of the Board of Immigration Appeals (Board) denying as untimely and numerically barred her motion to reopen immigration proceedings. We have reviewed the record and the Board's order and find that the Board did not abuse its discretion in denying the motion to reopen. See 8 C.F.R. § 1003.2(a), (c) (2006). Accordingly, we deny the petition for review for the reasons stated by the Board. See In re: Kamara, No. A70-679-571 (B.I.A. Dec. 8, 2005).
