PER CURIAM:

Willie Joe Williams appeals the district court's order accepting the recommendation of the magistrate judge and denying relief on his 42 U.S.C. § 1983 (2000) complaint. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, although we grant Williams's motion for leave to proceed in forma pauperis, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. See Williams v. Butler, No. 6:05-cv-01072-DCN (D.S.C.
