PER CURIAM:

Nelson Eddy Walker, a federal prisoner, appeals the district court's orders denying relief on his 28 U.S.C. § 2241 (2000) petition and his motion for reconsideration. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, although we grant leave to proceed in forma pauperis, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. Walker v.
