PER CURIAM:

Ronald Clifford Johnson appeals the district court's order entering judgment on the jury verdict and denying relief on his 42 U.S.C. § 1983 (2000) complaint. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm the district court's order. Johnson v. Clarke-Fauquier, No. 7:04-cv-00050-gec (W.D. Va. Sept. 27, 2006). We further deny Johnson's motion for the preparation of trial transcripts at government expense.
