PER CURIAM:

Brenda Sawada appeals the district court's order denying her motion filed under Fed. R. Civ. P. 56(f), and granting Defendants-Appellees' motion for summary judgment in this employment discrimination action. We have reviewed the parties' briefs and the joint appendix and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. Sawada v. Potter, No. 1:06-cv-00754-AMD (D. Md. Feb. 9, 2007).
