PER CURIAM:

Newport News Shipbuilding and Dry Dock Company seeks review of the Benefits Review Board's decision and order affirming the administrative law judge's award of attorney fees pursuant to 33 U.S.C. § 928 (2000). Our review of the record discloses that the Board's decision is without reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the Board. Newport News Shipbuilding & Dry Dock Co. v.
