PER CURIAM:

Thomas W. Hill appeals the district court's orders: (1) dismissing as interlocutory his appeal from the bankruptcy court's order enforcing certain terms of a settlement agreement; (2) denying his motion for recusal; and (3) denying his motion for reconsideration. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. Hill v. Hillier, No. 1:08-cv-00080-LHT (W.D.N.C. June 4, 2008 & July 23, 2008).
