PER CURIAM:

Pete Smith, a/k/a Jose, a/k/a Pete Noble Muhammad, petitions for a writ of mandamus, alleging the district court has unduly delayed acting on his motion to terminate his supervised probation. Accordingly, although we grant leave to proceed in forma pauperis, we deny the mandamus petition.
