PER CURIAM:

Clinton Matthew Ivey appeals the district court's order dismissing his 42 U.S.C. § 1983 (2006) civil rights action. On appeal, we confine our review to the issues raised in the Appellant's brief. See 4th Cir. R. 34(b). Because Ivey's informal brief does not challenge the basis for the district court's disposition, Ivey has forfeited appellate review of the court's order. Accordingly, we affirm the district court's judgment.
