PER CURIAM:

James K. Robinson appeals the district court's orders granting the Appellees' motion in limine to exclude Robinson's experts, granting summary judgment in favor of the Appellees on Robinson's claims of medical malpractice, and denying reconsideration. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. Robinson v. King, No. 2:09-cv-00418-RAJ-TEM (E.D. Va.
