PER CURIAM:

Jerold M. McElvaine seeks review of the Benefits Review Board's decision and order affirming the administrative law judge's denial of longshore disability benefits pursuant to 33 U.S.C. §§ 901-950 (2006). Our review of the record discloses that the Board's decision is based upon substantial evidence and is without reversible error.
