PER CURIAM:

Jorge Galeas, Jr., appeals the district court's order granting in part and denying in part his Fed. R. Civ. P. 59(e) motion seeking to alter or amend the court's earlier judgment dismissing his 42 U.S.C. § 1983 (2006) action as frivolous. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error.
