PER CURIAM:

Grover L. Dillon, Sr., petitions for a writ of mandamus, alleging the district court has unduly delayed acting on his 28 U.S.C.A. § 2255 (West Supp. 2011) motion. He seeks an order from this court directing the district court to act. Our review of the district court's docket reveals that, on February 14, 2012, the district court denied Dillon's § 2255 motion.
