PER CURIAM:

Amida Sannie, a native and citizen of Ghana, petitions for review of an order of the Board of Immigration Appeals (Board) dismissing her appeal from a decision of the Immigration Judge finding her ineligible for a good faith waiver under 8 U.S.C. § 1186a(c)(4)(C) (2006). We have reviewed Sannie's claims and the administrative record, and find no error. Accordingly, we deny the petition for review for the reasons stated by the Board. See In re: Sannie (B.I.A.
