PER CURIAM:

Gregory Marshall appeals the district court's order denying his request for a preliminary injunction. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. The motions for "emergency declaration for entry of default judgment" and for leave to proceed under the Prison Litigation Reform Act without prepayment of fees are denied.
