PER CURIAM:

Favio Secundino Vasquez-Perez, a native and citizen of Guatemala, petitions for review of an order of the Board of Immigration Appeals (Board) affirming the Immigration Judge's decision denying his motion for a continuance and pretermittting his application for cancellation of removal.
