PER CURIAM:

Kevin Lamont Walker appeals the district court's order denying his motion to reconsider the court's previous denial of his 18 U.S.C. § 3582(c)(2) (2006) motion for a sentence reduction. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. See United States v. Goodwyn, 596 F.3d 233, 235-36 (4th Cir. 2010) (district court does not have authority to reconsider prior order on § 3582 motion). Accordingly, we affirm the district court's order.
