PER CURIAM:

Larry R. Tart appeals the district court's order denying his motion to reconsider the dismissal of his 42 U.S.C. § 1983 (2006) complaint under 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(2)(B) (2012), and his motion to amend his complaint. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. Tart v. Sellers, No. 1:13-cv-00282-FDW (W.D.N.C. Nov. 22, 2013).
