PER CURIAM:

In these consolidated appeals, Kelso David Wallace appeals from the district court's orders denying relief on his civil complaint and his complaint filed pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983 (2012). We have reviewed the records and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. Wallace v. Lamson, No. 8:13-cv-00866-PWG (D. Md.
