PER CURIAM:

ESCgov, Inc., appeals from the district court's order granting summary judgment in favor of BMC Software, Inc., on its claims for breach of contract, tortious interference with a contract, civil conspiracy, and statutory conspiracy. We have reviewed the record and the parties' arguments on appeal, and we find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. See ESCgov, Inc. v.
