PER CURIAM:

Annie Fant appeals the district court's order dismissing her complaint under Fed. R. Civ. P. 12(b)(6). We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. Fant v. Wal-Mart Stores, Inc., No. 3:15-cv-00474-JAG (E.D. Va. Oct. 7, 2015). We grant Fant's motion for leave to proceed in forma pauperis, but deny as moot her motion to expedite the decision.
