PER CURIAM:

Robert L. Sisk appeals the district court's orders dismissing Sisk's civil complaint, which was filed against the United States pursuant to the Declaratory Judgment Act, 28 U.S.C. § 2201 (2012), and denying Sisk's Fed.
