PER CURIAM:

Appellant appeals from the district court's order granting summary judgment for the Defendants in Plaintiff's civil diversity action alleging false arrest and malicious prosecution. We have reviewed the record and the district court's opinion and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm on the reasoning of the district court. Fowler v. Atley, No. CA-93-830-Y (D. Md.
