PER CURIAM:

Appellant appeals from the district court's order dismissing his complaint for want of prosecution. We have reviewed the record and the district court's opinion and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm on the reasoning of the district court. Timpson v. Dreher, No. CA-95-2287-6-3AK (D.S.C. Feb. 6, 1996). We grant Appellant leave to proceed in forma pauperis in this Court.
