PER CURIAM:

Appellant appeals the district court's order granting summary judgment to the Defendant in a discrimination case filed under the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (Title VII)¹ and the Age Employment Discrimination Act (AEDA).² We have reviewed the record and the district court's opinion and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm on the reasoning of the district court.³ We dispense with oral argument because the facts and legal contentions are adequately presented in the materials before the court and argument would not aid the decisional process.
