PER CURIAM:

Appellant appeals the district court's orders denying relief on his petition filed under 28 U.S.C.A. § 2254 (West 1994 & Supp. 1997) and denying his motion for reconsideration. We have reviewed the record and the district court's opinion accepting the recommendation of the magistrate judge and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we deny a certificate of appealability and dismiss the appeal on the reasoning of the district court. Minter v. Angelone, No. CA-96-437-2 (E.D. Va. Oct. 1 & Dec. 3, 1996).
