PER CURIAM:

Amy and Yvonne Bryant seek to appeal the district court's order granting the Defendants' motion for summary judgment in the Appellants' action filed under 42 U.S.C.A. § 1983 (West Supp. 1998). We have reviewed the record and the district court's opinion and find no reversible error. We find that the Appellants' allegations fail to rise to the level of constitutional violations. Accordingly, we affirm. See Bryant v. Lovin, No. CA-98-68-7-F (E.D.N.C. Nov. 16, 1998).
